


WHAT IS THE FEDERATION OF STATES?

The Federation of States

***** Our Actual Sovereign Government ***** “The united States of America”

Created by the agreement known as: “The Unanimous Declaration of Independence of the united States of America”, 04 July 1776.
These “States” were the original geographically defined “estates” formed by the United Colonies.
They are guaranteed a “republican form of government”. Together, they formed — a Union, a Federation, and a Confederation:

The Federation of States

There are three Lawful Summoning Authorities charged with the responsibility of calling the State Assemblies into session.

- A. The President of the United States of America – the unincorporated Federation of States – vacated since 1860.
- B. A quorum of nine (9) State Assemblies already in session. Texas was the only State still in session.
- C. The owner of the Great Seals; the Head of State of the Federation of States.



The Federation of States

The Federation of States was formed in 1776 for the States to act together as one body in international and global jurisdictions.

The Federation **has no national level powers at all – and is therefore not in itself a sovereign body.** It is an agency of the States representing the sovereign bodies of the States of the Union in the foreign international and global jurisdictions.

It is an unincorporated Holding Company, which “holds” the international and global powers vouchsafed from the States for their mutual defense and protection.

Voluntary Hierarchy of Sovereign Power

Mankind breathes and bleeds, with standalone sovereign power.

State National Lawful Person – national soil jurisdiction

a sovereign body

State Citizen ASN accepting duties & obligations – International Land

State Citizens operate the unincorporated **State of the Union, Oklahoma.**

Oklahoma is a member of the unincorporated **Federation of States.**

Federation of States holds those international & global powers of the States.

Federation of States is the **Direct Party to the Constitutions.**

The Federation of States

In 1776, to operate in international and global business realms, the Federation needed to operate **under a recognized sovereign**.

This was inconvenient because each State could not be recognized as a sovereign in international jurisdiction **and** still have the advantage of mutually shared powers.

To clear this obstacle the Founders used the sovereign status of **William Belcher**, a patriot from Connecticut who later served in the Continental Army.



The Federation of States

William Belcher's family acquired sovereignty in England as a result of the Norman Conquest.

William Belcher believed that people should learn to be self-governing.

The Great Seals of both the United States (national) and the United States of America (International) are part of the Belcher Coat of Arms Array.



The Federation of States

As a result, William Belcher and his descendants became another safeguard for the new American Government.

The hereditary office of Head of State passes down to **James Clinton Belcher** and our American government because:

“every ship that sails”, sails under the Great Seals, meaning:

- all corporations, all ships and all commerce taking place worldwide,
- by American “vessels”.

The people who run The Federation’s Administration come from all over the country and are all volunteers; some are related to the Belle Chers, and some are not.



The Federation of States

Extra Belcher Notes:

- “Belcher” is an anglicized version of “Belle Cher”.
- The family is Norman French, not British.
- “Bel Cher” is a clan name, like “McDonald”
- It is proper to think of the Bel Chers as a clan.



The Federation of States

James Clinton Belcher is the husband of **Anna Von Reitz**.

James Belcher is the American Head of State, and Post Master, and Lawful Summoning Authority of the American State Assemblies.

Anna Von Reitz has accepted the obligation of the Fiduciary Office; handling global and international business.

Due to all the relationships described above, The American State Assemblies is the only organization which has summoned the 50 State Assemblies “**by the book**”; “**all the way**”, in harmony with that organic Constitution.

Responsibility of the Federation

The Federation has two main responsibilities:

1. **The Federation is the voice and authority for Americans within the international and global jurisdiction.**
 - It represents our country's interest in international court proceedings providing mutual defense.
 - It acts as the Holding Company to hold and manage the “mutually held” powers.
 - It has proven and announced our Assemblies standing to the International courts and to other sovereign powers, declaring our lawful standing as the only legitimate government for the 50 States of the Union.

Responsibility of the Federation

- Anna Von Reitz established **The Living Law Firm** in Alaska; a group of Lawyers who gave up their BAR card status as attorneys.
- James Belcher, Anna Von Reitz, The Living Law Firm, other researchers and families across the world have all been pushing back the encroachment of corporate feudalism.
- They have been working to restore our Republic and create peace by finding and applying lawful remedies to international crimes against the people.

Responsibility of the Federation

2. Although the Federation is not a sovereign body, it does **have the fiduciary obligation to ensure that the Assemblies created are:**
 - “Peaceable”
 - composed of qualified people living within the borders of each State.
 - Who have declared and recorded their birthright political status.
 - From there, to provide the discipline, framework and guidance to establish the Four Pillars for each State Assembly.

Responsibility of the Federation

- Please note: this process is not given to interpretation – it has been followed to the letter.
- The Federation must ensure the legal and peaceable nature of the process and the State Assemblies that result from it.
- Or our activities could be mistaken as hostile actions and legally suppressed by military force.
- The Federation has provided our assemblies with the declarations to correct our political status – the 1779 Declaration and “the 928’s”.



The Federation of States

Responsibility of the Federation

- The Federation vets and assigns coordinators for each State of the Union to begin the Assembling Process.
- The Federation provides oversight and protection for each State during this process.
- Coordinators are all State Nationals, serving as Federation Officers, under their direction and instruction.
- During this time of reconstruction, if Assemblies get off track, the Federation **has the ability to dissolve an entire Assembly**, in order to be reorganized the correct way.



The Federation of States

Responsibility of the Federation

- An American State Assembly is considered “fully seated” when it is:
 - Composed of properly declared and recorded Americans
 - Fully operational with all 4 Pillars operating and all offices filled.



The Federation of States

Responsibility of the Federation

- Once fully seated:
 - The State Assembly inherits all rights, titles, and interests for the State.
 - The State Assembly is **responsible for**:
 - performing under the treaties and constitutional agreements already established,
 - supporting the restored American Government and reconstruction
 - for the conduct of the restored **Confederation** and **Federal Republic**.
